Boston Light is the last staffed Coast Guard Light Station in the country with one Coast Guard civilian (paid) Keeper and a cadre of CG Auxiliary trained Assist Keepers staffing the island and maintaining the grounds. This is on-the-job advanced training with a 3-5 year commitment being sought by candidates. Rotation for duty is either Sun-Wed or Wed-Sun. Once qualified, Assistant Keepers perform at least one duty per year during the months of June-Oct. Candidates need to possess innate social skills to appropriately interact with visitors, co-Auxiliarists, Coast Guard personnel, and members of the other “partners” of the Boston Harbor Islands National Park. Candidates also need to be physically capable of safely performing such tasks as climbing the 100 foot tower twice a day, grounds work (mowing the lawn, painting), while maintaining situational awareness at all time.
