Required training dates:

Sunday, 1 May 2016 (0830-1300) “ashore” training at Coast Guard Base Boston
at the function hall

AND

Saturday, 18 June 2016 (0915-1630) “on-island” orientation at Boston Light via
the National Park chartered vessel

Expectations: perform a minimum of 3 Interpreter “day duties” per season, properly wearing of the ODU. There will be 16 weeks of tours held Friday, Saturday, and Sun with approximately 48 tour days to choose from.
