Identification Card Renewal Process

Please note that the renewal process for the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary Identification Card has changed:

Members are required to have a digital photo taken of them. The photo must be taken with the member wearing the light blue uniform shirt (Trops) and the member must be standing in front of a solid RED background. <u>VIRTUAL BACKGROUNDS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE</u> The photo must be saved in **JPEG** (Not .png) format and emailed to the Director's Office in Boston per the directions below.

Include the following Information in the Email:

- Name (First, MI, Last)
- Weight
- Height
- Hair Color
- Eye Color
- Blood Type (if known)

Attach the JPEG photo to the email.

DO NOT SEND ANY PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION (PII) VIA EMAIL

NOTE: To get your ID Card Renewed, you MUST be current in all Core Training Requirements.

Photo Requirements:

- 1. Member wearing Tropical Blue shirt.
- 2. Hair longer than collar length must be pinned or tied back. No hair on shoulders.
- 3. Red actual background (No virtual backgrounds).
- 4. Flat lighting is best.
- 5. Do not use portrait mode if possible. Photos need lateral space for editing.
- 6. Photo must be in Jpeg format. ID System will not accept .png.
